For the book, see [Playbook \(book\)](#). Edit information Barney dusts off his playbook filled with strategies on how to pick women and Lily seeks to put an end to this. Ted and Marshall insist that Robin is about to fall in love. Recap [Future's Recap](#) [Future summary](#) explains that the key to dating was the self-confidence Barney had in spades, but usually that confidence was in character. We turn to Barney sitting in McLaren in a full scotch suit. Lily pushes the woman in the bar, warning her of Barney's villainy. This woman (Claire) sits down with the rest of the gang, explaining the events that led to the night. After the breakup, Barney and Robin had different approaches to survival. Robin said she wanted to throw herself into her career, but Marshall and Ted are convinced she will find the love of her life, citing a few friends who gave up dating to focus on their work, only to get married (or in a civil union) months later. Barney, on the other hand, decided to return to the scene of the acquaintance with a vengeance, using his sacred Playbook. The book describes a set of scam scenarios designed to seduce a woman. Meanwhile, Lily tries to set up Ted with a fellow teacher Shelley. Initially, she tried to get them to meet, but she found Ted and Marshall in the middle of trying to fill their mouth with a chicken finger, so she convinced that her colleague Ted wasn't there. But Ted got up, and after confronting Shelley, Lily learns that she was seduced by an exotic man in a McLaren pub. Lily realizes that it was Barney, and understandably outraged. Barney describes the play he used, Lorenzo von Matterhorn, using fake websites, a smartphone and an exotic name. In retaliation, Lily's actress friend pretends to get caught on He won't come to distract Barney, steals the Playbook and threatens to publish it online if Barney doesn't stop deceiving women to sleep with him (although Barney initially accuses al-qaeda, which he mispronounced, saying zae as K). Later, he shows up at the apartment in the aforementioned scuba suit, saying he'll be at the bar performing Scuba Diver, a play he snatched from the Playbook, so the gang goes down to find out what it is. Claire, Lily's girlfriend approached at the beginning of the episode, is also curious to know what the underwater suit is for, so the gang sits with Barney. He begins to behave audaciously, but Barney eventually breaks down, admitting that his breakup with Robin hurts him, and that was how he coped. Touched, the gang strongly advises Claire to go out with Barney for a cup of coffee. After they leave, the gang receives a text from Barney and finds a description of Scuba Diver under their desk in McLaren. It was actually a sophisticated and long con, involving Lily's disgust on the Playbook, revealing Barney's tricks to his prey (Claire), Barney's fake breakdown over his breakup, and his friends encouraging the booty to go with Barney, the gang was thoroughly deceived. Lily says: You're a sonuubich! Finally, a new co-host, Don, arrives at Robin's pre-show. Future Ted says: It was the day she met Don. Robin says: Gosh, Marshall is quiet to herself, as if she suddenly realized that Ted and Marshall's taunts may have been some truth. Lily's continuity mentions reading Robin's two-volume Playbook (i.e. her breasts), an example of her bi-curiousy. Lily says: You're a son-and-go. Barney first mentions pretending to be an astronaut to sleep with a woman in a bracket. Lily asks Marshall to put the Playbook on the Internet. Marshall demonstrates his knowledge of building websites in everything that needs to go, Barney's Ted Mosby play involves wearing the same clothes Ted was in happily ever after, after Stella ran away with Tony on their wedding day at Asylum Island, and telling the girls that he stayed at the altar. Barney first mentions the site he created in Possimible. Future Links (contains spoilers) The first time Robin meets Don expands into the last cigarette ever. They end up getting together, of course, before parting ways with the Doppelgangers. Of course, it turned out that Robin was upset by Barney's insensitivity after their breakup, and actually started crying after leaving the apartment when he described the girl he hooked up with the help he wouldn't come. Matt Blitz, an accountant GNB Marshall tells Robin about, shares his name with the first Blitz mentioned in Blitzgiving. They probably aren't the same person as the first Blitz unlucky because he threw Wesleyan before school went on a joint deal, while the accountant is now in a civil union with a man. Barney tells the gang in The Best Man that he is doing market research on his plays in small markets like Cleveland in order to figure out which ones will work in New York, and has seen field-testing plays like Escape Manslaughterer and Patient zero. Barney destroys the ceremonial version of the Playbook in Over-Correction, and Jeanette destroys the real Playbook in Bad Crazy. Barney recreates the Playbook on napkins and gives it to Kyle and Justin at sunrise. While the gang doubts My Penis Grant Wishes will work, it's apparently already on Kelly's mother's friend, as shown in How Your Mother Met Me, presumably at the St. Patrick's Day party from No Tomorrow. In Vesuvius, Ted tells his mother that Barney stole a scuba suit and walked down Broadway in it. Barney also celebrates his return to one life, and seduces a woman under false draw that his friends have plans for an on-the-nanny. Playbook Methods Don't Drink that Barney claims that someone slipped something in the girl's drink. SNASA Barney claims to the girl that he is an astronaut from SNASA (Secret NASA), and when the girl asks about space, he claims that he knows about SMOON (Secret of the Moon). Ted Mosby Barney wears Ted's clothes and claims to the girl that he just left at the altar. Mrs. Stinesfire Barney becomes the new mother of the house in Sorority. Cheap Stunt Barney claims to be the bass player of Cheap Trick. He won't come to the girls he meets until one of them believes him. Lorenzo von Matterhorn Barney finds a girl who has a good cell phone and claims to be famous, the girl will then be web searching Lorenzo and found some makeup site Barney prepared, then Lorenzo returns, and the girl will adore him (Note: Lorenzo says a lie, except for one: he said he won the 3rd place on the laser tag championship, but he said that the competition was in the Vatican). Underwater diver Barney waits in a bar with costume, while the gang tells the girl that she is going to be the next victim, but before that, Barney must first make Lorenzo von Matterhorn with one of the gang's friends (in this case, this is Lily's friend), then Lily will explain all the lies to her friend. Forcing her to hire an actress who seduces Barney and then steal the Playbook, Barney will then make an underwater diver who can't be found anywhere in the book, making the gang a curious underwater diver, then the gang will ask about Diver scuba and Barney will tell his next victim. The gang will tell the girl all about Barney. Then the gang plus the girl asks Barney about the underwater diver. Barney then surrenders, and then asks the girl for coffee. After Barney and the girl leave, the gang will find a note under their table, which will explain the Underwater Diver. Notes and trivia of Goofy and errors The search result for Lorenzo von Matterhorn, which pops up on the screen immediately after Barney leaves Shelley in the bar, one of the search results called Lorenzo von Matterhorn is not a jerk, and the page to which he refers. Earlier in the series (in the bracket), this site was created by Anna, with whom Barney slept at the beginning of season 2 and to whom he lied that he was the architect of Ted Mosby. The website was her way of paying Barney back. Technically speaking, Barney would have had to hack into the website's hosting server in order to insert Lorenzo von Matterhorn's article into it. (Robin wasn't there when Lily said it to Barney.) But when Lily tried to download the Playbook, Robin was there and must have known Lily had it. Ergo, she shouldn't have been surprised when Lily showed it at the bar. During the scene in which Ted and Marshall play on the Xbox 360, one of the controllers is missing the battery. Initially, Ted's controller is missing the battery, while Marshall's controller has a battery. Then, when Marshall talks about frozen waffles, his controller lacks battery. As soon as Marshall finishes talking about frozen waffles, Marshall's controller has a battery, and Ted doesn't. Allusions and External References When the Playbook opens, Marshall jokes about how prolific author Barney - referring to Bro Code - is comparing him to prolific author Stephen King. Barney describes a play called Mrs. Stinesfire, where he dresses as a woman, a reference to the Film by Robin Williams of Mrs. Homefire. In one of his plays, Barney claims to be the bassist for Cheap Trick. Marshall describes a lot of people who get married after leaving the dating scene. A pair in the form of Star Trek is shown. One gay colleague finds the love of his life, but they are the exception, instead of declaring them married, Marshall describes in anticipation of legislation on the floor of the New York State Senate, a reference to the debate over same-sex marriage. After Ted meaning MILSWANCA (Mothers I would like to sleep with and never call again), an alternative acronym for MILOM, correct. Barney says: Right! The circle gets squared, a reference to the Game Show Hollywood Square. Barney's play about his Penis Granting Wishes says that eventually he starts singing and furniture about life. This is a reference to Beauty and the Beast. Music by Rondo Alla Turka - Mozart accompanies sequences from Barney's Playbook. The piano version of Nino Roth What Is Youth from the 1968 film version of Romeo and Juliet used when Barney finally succeeds with He Won't Come Play. Other notes in the cockpit Barney sits while in his scuba gear there is a sign that says: On this site in 1897 ... Nothing happened. This sign is visible in several other episodes, such as Double Date, when the gang is on the corner of the stand. It is also visible in the intro sequence. After airing this episode, Lorenzo von Matterhorn (one of barney's playbook aliases) became the fastest growing Google search of the day of November 16, 2009. The show created websites mentioned in the episode: Balloon Explorers Club, Big Business Journal, Extremities quarterly. Lorenzo von Matterhorn's Wikipedia page was also set up on October 21, but was deleted when the show revealed it was a hoax.
